Edmond-Dune Scholarship: theatrical writing scholarship and editing assistance for professional theatrical structure.



As part of its live performance support policy, the National Cultural Fund offers a theatrical writing aid grant to an author and editing aid to a professional theatrical structure to perform the winning work. The main objective is to accompany the process of creating an innovative work in the field of the performing arts.

Eligibility

The grant is awarded on the basis of a call for projects to all authors of Luxembourg nationality or resident in Luxembourg, without age criteria. Co-writes may be submitted, but must indicate the names of all the authors of the project.

The grant scheme is divided into two parts:

Theatrical writing grant: EUR 5,000. If the work is the result of collaboration between several authors, the grant is divided equally between them.

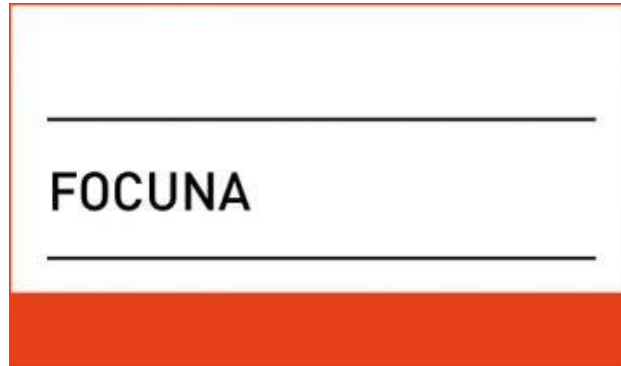
Set-up grant: maximum grant of 10,000 EUR for the professional theatrical structure chosen by the author to represent his work.

FOCUNA 40 YEARS SCHOLARSHIP



On the occasion of its 40th anniversary, the National Cultural Fund offers a grant for students, doctoral students or researchers on the basis of a call for applications. This academic grant aims to encourage them to dedicate their research to cultural patronage in Luxembourg.

Eligibility

The National Cultural Fund awards a scholarship on the basis of a call for applications to all students, doctoral students or researchers who are officially attached to a university, a college or a scientific institution, preparing for a 2nd or 3rd cycle diploma (master's, doctorate, post-doctorate) and presenting a research project on cultural patronage in Luxembourg. Projects written in Luxembourgish, German, French and English are eligible.

Material and financial conditions

Research grant: 15,000 EUR

Francis-André scholarship - "Carte blanche"



The National Cultural Fund, in collaboration with private patrons, offers a “carte blanche” grant to an artist or collective of artists in the field of visual arts. The objective is to support an artist or collective of artists in the process of research, creation or production of innovative projects.

ELIGIBLE PROJECTS

The grant is awarded on the basis of a call for projects to all artists or artists' collectives of Luxembourg nationality or residing in Luxembourg, without age criteria, who can attest to a professional career of at least five years. The grant aims to support an artist or collective of artists in the process of research, creation or production of innovative projects.

Material and financial conditions Grant of EUR 10,000 paid in several installments to the personal account of the artist or collective of artists.

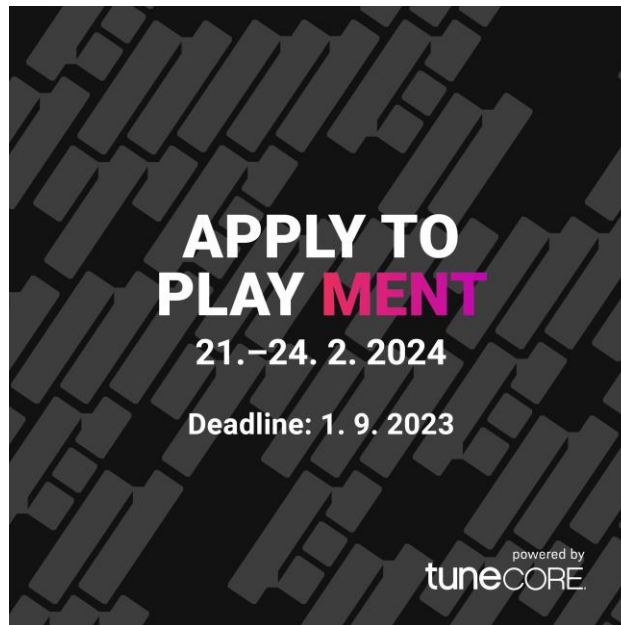
