TOOLKIT TRAINING ACTIVITY IN ATHENS, GREECE

In November 2022, the #WeCoLead project partners met for a training activity in Athens, Greece, hosted by COMMON. The aim of the training was for the partners to get introduced to Toolkit for young women's leadership, which was created as a result of the harvests and co-creation phase!

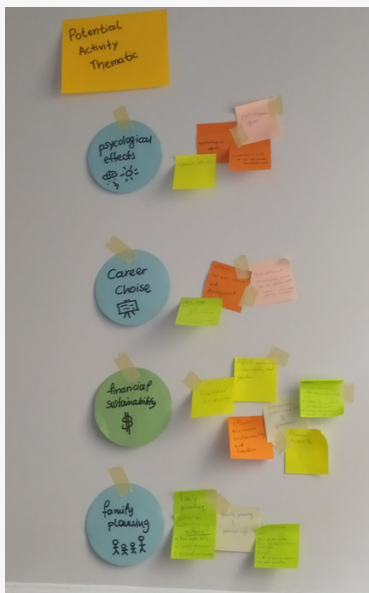
During the Toolkit training, COMMON introduced the Civil Society Toolbox methodology, which served as the basis for the #wecolead Toolkit. The focus was on testing different methods and paths that are part of the Toolkit for young women's empowerment and community-building.



#COCREATETHETOOLKIT

The second Project Result of the #WeCoLead project included the following activities implemented so far:

- 84 responses were collected from young women and civil society representatives in the 5 countries during the harvest phase on the topics of collective impact and barriers to young women's leaderships in the labour market, entrepreneurship, sustainable practices, inspiration, & personal life.
- 54 participants (both young women & organizational representatives, youth workers) were involved in the local co-creation workshops in each country. Collective knowledge & ideas on how to better advocate & support young women were discussed!



#WeCoLead is a KA2 Strategic Partnership co-funded by the Erasmus + of the European Union. Led by SwIdeas in Sweden, the project also gathers partnerships from Italy (CESIE), Greece ('COMMON), Hungary (SVF - Subjective Values Foundation), and Luxembourg (FSL - Formation et Sensibilisation de Luxembourg). #WeCoLead is a KA2 Erasmus+ project with the goal of empowering young women to act as leaders in shaping the sustainable new normal and fighting against climate change, acting as change-makers, and exploring their active citizenship and socio-economic potential.



NEXT STEPS OF #WECOLEAD



The next steps of the project will include the following activities and results:

- **#CoCreatetheToolkit:** now that the Toolkit has been developed, including methodologies on how to build sustainable communities and advocate for women's rights supporting their leadership, it will be tested in each partner country directly with the target group.

During this project result, the partners in Sweden, Italy, Greece, Hungary, and Luxembourg will conduct local testing activities with **young women, local community leaders** and supporting organizations working with young women. These will aim to test the Toolkit material developed, getting feedback on the usability and accessibility of the content and modules/paths created for empowerment, advocacy, and community-building in the fields of gender & sustainability.

- **#SoThatMoreCanCome:** the development of an e-booklet for youth workers collecting all project results.
